Tournament Rules and Guidelines

Guaranteed three games

No AAU teams allowed

The top 2 teams in each division will advance to the finals

Regular MIAA High School rules will be followed with the exception; shooting two begins at the 10th foul. (No one and one at the 7th foul)

All high school rules will be enforced such as three seconds and backcourt

Every player must be in the 6th, 7th or 8th grade

Two timeouts per team, per half, no carry over to second half or overtime

Overtime is two minutes, stop time and one timeout per team

Each half is 20 minutes running time with stop time the last 2 minutes of game

In the event of a 2 way tie in the standings, the tie will be broken in the following order 1) head to head record, 2) record against common opponents, 3) points given up against common opponents, 4) coin toss. The top 2 teams determined by tiebreakers will be in the finals. All decisions will be finalized by the tournament committee

In the spirit of the tournament, we ask that teams not press trap or double team if the lead grows to 20 points. We ask that no more than 3 coaches are on the bench. If we need scorers, we will ask each team to supply a volunteer

IIABO certified officials are volunteering their time

We run the tournament to honor a former board member and we expect all teams to act in a sporting and proper manner
